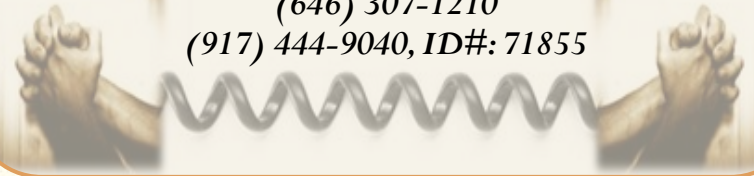

Context

Overcomers are followers of Christ who successfully resist the power and temptation of the world's system. All Christians are called to be overcomers, but the reality is that not all Christians choose to be. To be identified as an overcomer in this world requires complete dependence upon God for direction, fulfillment, and strength with a passionate dedication to the service of Christ despite our circumstances. An overcomer is not sinless but holds fast to faith in Christ until the end. It's not by might nor by power but by the indwelling Spirit that empowers believers as we remain surrendered to His leading.

John 16:33 says, "In the world ye have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world." Jesus is our ultimate overcomer. He overcame temptation (Matthew 4:11; Philippians 2:8; Hebrews 2:18). He overcame rejection and loss (Hebrews 12:1-2). He overcame death, being resurrected after three days. Jesus, the Overcomer, is now seated on the throne as King of kings and Lord of lords. "To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and set down with my Father in his throne" (Revelation 3:21). At the end of each letter to the seven churches in Revelation 2-3, there is a promise to the one who "overcomes". The rewards to each church are designed as the ideal rewards for overcomers and the difficulties and troubles that each endured. Overcomers will be greatly rewarded. They will reign with Christ in glory.
